Randall D. Isaac Accepts Directorship of the American Scientific Affiliation

The ASA is pleased to announce the appointment of its new executive director, Dr. Randall D. Isaac.

Randy received his B.S. in physics at Wheaton College in 1972 and his Ph.D. in solid-state physics at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. He joined the IBM Thomas J. Watson Research Center as a researcher in silicon technology in 1977. He became a research manager in 1981 and joined the executive ranks in 1987. Most recently he was IBM Research VP of Systems, Science, and Technology.

Randy describes his Christian faith as "permeating all aspects of life." He is an active member of his church, a non-denominational Bible church, and was raised in the independent Mennonite church. Described as having a

brilliant mind and a passionate heart for the truth of Christ, Randy is committed to the integration of science and theology.

An ASA member since 1976 and an ASA fellow since 1996, Randy has presented papers at Annual Meetings and has published in *Perspectives on Science and Christian Faith*. Randy was also an active member of the New York area local section. He is a member of the ASA Advisory Council.
